Award: Up to FIVE, \$500 scholarship(s) to high school seniors who has participated in a junior varsity or varsity sport or cheerleading for at least two complete seasons during high school.

Applicant Qualifications:

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior from Folsom High School or Vista del Lago High School.
2. The applicant must have a 3.0 GPA for 4 years of high school.
3. The applicant must have participated in at least two seasons of a junior varsity or varsity sport or cheerleading for at least two complete seasons during high school.
4. The applicant must have been involved in extracurricular activities, with an emphasis on service to others.

Application Procedures:

1. Complete the attached application form and return to the counseling office.
2. Include with your application an unofficial transcript.
3. Include two letters of recommendation.

Selection:

Selection of the scholarship award winner will be made on the basis of the application and interview. The high school counseling office will contact you with interview date and time.

Selected students will be asked to provide a record of acceptance or class schedule to the college of their choice after receiving the scholarship award.

Application Deadline: Thursday, April 5, 2018 - 3:00pm.

Applications will not be accepted late or incomplete.
