Park Planning

- Lynn presented a package that is essentially a summary and status of development for all of the Folsom Parks
- Some history was provided as to how they became a park
- Mentioned park fees have increased to bring Folsom more in line with other cities. Have not reaped the benefits just yet, but the account is growing.
- Lynn Mentioned all South of 50 parks will fund themselves separately from the rest of Folsom. Existing Folsom parks will not be able to pull funding from south of 50.
