- Began conversation on how to pay for this. Current fund has \$7k. Can pay for this year through the fund, with a \$2k buffer, but in the future want to use Fireworks fundraiser to help pay for Lois Young by:
- Assuming fireworks averages \$50/hr per volunteer hour, since FAA administers this program would like to take \$5/hr off the top to go into the Lois Young program.
- Also want to allow Mad Dog Wrestling and Music Booster into Fireworks Fundraiser, would get \$10/hr back to go into fund.
- Some members questioned why their organization should take the hit.
- Mike Raffetto outlined the history of the FAA administering the fireworks fundraiser
- Rich F. mentioned that the scholarship candidates likely played for many of the sports organizations through the years and the money is going back into the kids.
- **Mike R motion to approve \$5 coming back for FAA administration of Fireworks. Mike D. 2nd. (20 in favor, no opposed)**
