



## Application for Community Youth Sports Group Membership

1. Partnership with FAA must be mutually beneficial. Impacts to existing youth programs and facilities are key items that will be reviewed and considered.
2. New applicants understand the youth organization must enter into a Memo of Understanding (MOU) with the FAA. The MOU will need to be updated on a semi-annual basis, signed by the clubs president.
3. No membership shall be approved by the FAA until the City of Folsom and the Folsom-Cordova Unified School District have also issued their comments or approvals.
4. Youth sports programs with 1 team only, will not be considered for membership.

\_\_\_\_\_ Short narrative describing facility needs, current maintenance level, impact on current programs.

Upon receipt of this application and supporting documents, the FAA Board in partnership with the City of Folsom Park and Recreation Department, and the Folsom Cordova Unified School District will review and discuss the applicant at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.

**Once the Board has discussed the application, the Organization will be contacted to provide a representative to meet with the FAA Board for a 5-10 min. interview. The FAA will then make a final determination for membership.**
