March 16, 2021 Adopt and FAA Meeting Minutes

Meeting opened at 6:32 p.m. by Michael Raffetto

Adopt a Facility financial update: no activity to update by Derik Perez.

Adopt projects

<u>Derik Perez</u>: completed resurfacing the basketball courts at the Andy Morin Sports Complex, FYBA helped with the project; working with Kristen to add a storage shed at Econome Park – waiting for updated quote.

<u>Tim O'Shea</u>: working on the little league dirt fields and pitching mound, Tom offered to get volunteers to help with the warning tracks. Working on getting all the fields fertilized, Burma grass slow to green. Cell tower work at Mann tore up the park and some concrete pads; saw the safety fence caps on the outfield fencing at Sheldon and other parks. Need to fix the shade screen at Sheldon – backstop baseball field.

Thanks to the FAA who stepped up to work on the Lembi sign. A shout out to Dave and crew!

Heads up: Prop 68 allocated \$277,000 to help revamp parks. Money used for Ed Mitchell Park – changing the lights to LED on courts 1-4, windscreens on tennis courts, resurfacing the courts. Hoping to have some money to refit the fixtures in restrooms. Broken goals at Sheldon Park back side of hockey rink – Tim to schedule to get rid of.

<u>FCUSD</u>: per <u>Derik Perez</u>: Mangini Ranch Elementary scheduled to be complete and ready for 2021-22 school year. Moving forward with Blanche Sprentz multi-purpose room. Elementary schools opened March 17.

Youth Groups – facility related issues

Soccer: city is taking care of their request.

Softball: no updates; managing their own fields, they are good.

FYBA: no issues.

Lacrosse: one bathroom at Livermore is locked all the time; other lock do not always lock.

Talons Boys: Rachel Silva-Henry new to the board, season officially on hold.

Vista Jr. Eagles Football & Cheer: what are the lights at Sutter looking like, side fencing between bleachers and shed are littered with garbage.

FEBA: got the memo that the sports complex is opening, wants to use the outside courts, will bring their own lights. Ready for tryouts. There has been light issue at different parks and vandalism (Nisenan Park).

Covered roof project: contract executed, kick off meeting with Two Rivers architects in a couple of weeks. Project entails two outdoor basketball courts with a roof and lights and sports courts. Will be striped for basketball, volleyball, Pickleball. Can do futsal.

Folsom Baseball: Bryan, U11 Coach. Irrigation / sprinkles issue 1st and 2nd base, pitchers area, puddles and mess at Caitlin Park. Neighbor dogs are tearing up the fields – would love to get some kind of signs made.

Vista Boosters: no issue.

Not present at the meeting: Aspire Volleyball, Folsom American Little League, National American Little League, Fusion Basketball, Folsom Jr. Bulldogs & Cheer, FHS Boosters, Sea Otters, and Sierra Marlins.

FAA Meeting

<u>February meeting minutes</u>: motion to approve Kendra Miller, second Dan Palhegyi, all in favor Aye.

<u>FAA Treasurers report</u>: received \$550 donation to Ernie Sheldon Legacy Fund and \$2,000 for Time to Thrive scholarship. Motion to approve Tom Handy, second Kendra, all in favor Aye.

<u>Guest Speaker</u>: Jamie Fox high school varsity Lacrosse coach at Vista. Working with Folsom Lacrosse to get lacrosse at FHS. Collecting pledges and fundraising money to show the district and school that they can start program. District want to see if they can raise \$15,000 by October; currently at \$8,000. Reaching out to the FAA to pledge and help fund the program. Board to discuss; possibly through the Ernie Sheldon Legacy Fund.

<u>Guest Speaker</u>: Jessica Anderson and husband coached soccer in Folsom and ARFC and Vista Lacrosse (with Jamie Fox). During the pandemic, the family discussed - what can we do to help high school students? Time to Thrive was created with three scholarships for Folsom and Rancho Cordova students: sports, music, and academic.

<u>Derik Perez COVID update</u>: reminder to all the leaguers to follow the guidelines, remind coaches while on the field to wear a mask, kids in the dugout to wear a mask. Reaching capacity with all open sports.

Andy Morin Spots Complex will be open March 23, Monday-Friday 10 am-9 pm. – masks are required. Courts are available to rent, batting cages are open; looking to bring back adult sports – adult soccer and softball. Hiring sports scorekeepers, site monitors, and administrators. Everything is outdoors right now; indoor facilities will be awhile.

<u>Spring Eggstravaganza April 3</u> – Dan Palhegyi: walk through event at the Folsom Palladio; drive through event at CalFit.

<u>Fireworks</u> – Joyce Fuchs: 13 leagues have submitted their applications.

<u>CYSL dues</u>: no fees were collected in 2020; will be collecting in 2021. Annual fee of \$50 to be collected in July.

Community youth sports clubs update

Mad Dawg Wrestling: hoping to sneak in a high school season.

Vista Jr. Eagles & Cheer: just announced registration; working on clinic and tryout end of April.

Vista Athletic Boosters: season started with 600-700 athletes on campus. Waiting for clarification to start indoor sports.

FEBA: running spring tryouts, high school practice starts April 5, league starts April 15.

Vista Talons: on hold until further notice.

FYBA: not a lot going on. Doing their own scholarship; have 18 applicants. Will award four scholarships.

American Little League: have over 535 kids ready to play. Upper division 14/15 ages, majors division 10, 11, 12, age, and AAA ages 9, 10, 11. Got a waiver to take on some FHS freshmen for a junior division. Have 32 teams 8 and younger. Plan 15-20 game season. Provided scholarships to 5 to 6 kids. FREE umpire clinic 13 years + next week, pays \$40 per game.

Lacrosse: games start April 10, kicking off with scrimmages March 20. Preparing teams and families to follow COVID protocols, sideline masks and social distance, have ~200 kids have signed up.

Derik: want to thank all the youth groups for what they are doing for the kids in the community. Your responsiveness to the return to play guidelines and the being able to adapt to the changing world. Communicating and the partnering, hats off, we appreciate all you have done for the kids and community.

Sea Otters: No change in our status. Still in enrollment and season planning. If all goes well we start our season April 26. We are interested in the fireworks fundraiser.

Soccer: first official game last week, open recreation registration April 1.

Softball: 250 girls' registered, need volunteers to coach, board running short handed, week April 5, 12 game season.

Not present at the meeting: NorCal Wrestling, National Little League, Folsom Baseball, Fusion Basketball, Aspire Volleyball, Sierra Marlins, Folsom Jr. Eagles & Cheer, Folsom Athletic Boosters

Board updates

Will Kempton: city council meeting regarding use of facility at Sheldon Park, council approved to use the Brighton Building for Parks & Recreation, facility, 10,000 square feet, seven rooms, kitchen, and yard. Will be able to plan future program - Vacation Zone, Fun Factory, Pottery, and Arts. Least fees help pay off Sheldon Park.

Kuntz Park is getting worse and worse. Homeless, drugs – is this on Folsom's radar? Will Kempton to take this up with Tom O'Shea; this is totally unacceptable.

Dave: thanks to Mike and Tom for your help finishing signs and working the football game.

Tom: need to get together to talk about opening snack bar.

Rich: need determine how to do the in person scholarship interviews; need to get with Matt Long regarding Telegraph article.

Lynn: good.

Michael: credit to Dave for cutting out 27 new letters by hand to form Home of Folsom Athletic Association sign.

Jen: no update, waiting to hear from Matt from the Telegraph. Keep the ball rolling on scholarships.

Tim: when will we be doing the project at Memorial field and surrounding area.

Dan: question? Do lacrosse balls have a shelf life? Answer: will take used balls; they can be dropped off Livermore Park Monday-Thursday 5-9 p.m.

Kyle: no update.
